Itinerary:

Day 1. Arrival in Warsaw.

We will meet you at the airport or at the hotel for a welcome dinner. a welcome dinner.

Day 2. Warsaw, the capital of a multicultural kingdom.

A visit in the newly opened Museum of The History of Polish Jews and Wilanów Palace and Park. In the evening we will have dinner in modern area of Warsaw.

Day 3. Chopin, charm of a little town and a countryside.

The open-air piano concert with music by Frederic Chopin in Royal Łazienki Park. In the afternoon leave Warsaw to Podlasie region. Visiting Tykocin.

Day 4. Lithuania.

Today we will go to the capital of Lithuania: Vilnius, where you will spend the next 2 days. During our guided tour you will visit the famous "Gate of Dawn" (Ostra Brama), and the Giedymin Castle.

Day 5. Vilnius and Trakai.

Today we will continue our day in Vilnius and in the afternoon we will visit the old castle in Trakai located on an island.

Day 6. Białowieża forest and Podlasie region.

We will leave Vilnius and return to Poland with short breaks in Białystok or Augustów. Visit in the Orthodox Monastery in Supraśl, and in the afternoon we will arrive in Hajnówka, to visit the Show Reserve of the European bison.

Day 7. Tatars world.

Today we will try to show you the free living Bison which can be at fingertips. In the afternoon travel to Kruszyniany to see the oldest wooden, Tatar mosque in Poland. In the evening be prepared for the Tatars traditional cuisine!

Day 8. "The gate to the east": Lublin.

On the way to Lublin, we will stop in Kozłówka to visit the Zamoyski family residence. In the afternoon guided tour in Lublin.

Day 9. The charming Roztocze region.

Discover the Roztocze National Park: featuring Polish Pony breeding and the natural, wild forest in Florianka. We will then visit the town of Zwierzyniec and then the renaissance town of Zamość.

Day 10. Rejuvenation of your body and soul – the town of artists.

Kazimierz Dolny, one of the most beautifully situated little towns in Poland. In the afternoon come back to Warsaw and a farewell dinner in the Old Town.

Day 11. The departure day.

After breakfast check out from the hotel and we will accompany you to the airport.

Weather and climate

Please be prepared for changing weather: a warmer garment should be included and comfortable shoes are a must. The summer is mild here, with temperatures ranging between 50 and 70 degrees. However remember, the weather can be capricious here.

Health

When coming to Poland and Lithuania no special vaccinations are required.

In case of any illness you can pay to use the services of the local healthcare system.

If you took out the appropriate insurance before you set off, the costs of treatment will be refunded when you get back home.

In case of an accident, sudden illness, injury, poisoning or lifethreatening conditions, you are entitled to receive all forms of medical treatment without a referral.

Electricity

220v/50 cycles. Allpurpose transformer and 2prong adapter is required for U.S. appliances.

Tipping

Not obligatory, but appreciated.

Cab drivers and waiters accept between 10-15%. In some places there is also a nominal charge for use of cloak rooms and public restrooms.

Currency and credit cards

Polish monetary unit is Zloty divided into 100 groszy. 1 Polish zloty (PLN) = about 0.24 US dollars (USD) (December 2016)

Lithuanian monetary unit is Euro. 1 EUR = about 1.04 USD (December 2016)

VISA, MasterCard credit cards are accepted in major shops, restaurants, cafes, hotels.

Internet

You will have wifi (wireless Internet connection) in all your hotels.

Tour terms and conditions:

Reservations/payment

For reservation make a deposit of 800 Polish zlotys per person and provide your chosen dates by filling the reservation form on the page <http://kingdom.polishorigins.com>

The remaining amount of payment is due 32 days before planned date of starting the Tour. The rates are in Polish zlotys. We operate in Poland as a licensed Polish business entity and we accept payments in Polish zlotys (PLN).

Documents:

A valid passport is required. Check the validity of your passport and be sure it is valid for at least three months after your return date.

Cancellations:

If a tour has less than 5 persons who have made reservations 2 months planned date of starting the Tour, we reserve the right to cancel the whole Tour. In that case all deposits for that Tour date will be refunded.

Higher forces:

It might occur partial or complete breach of contract, caused by unforeseeable events such as fire, war, natural disaster, or any other acts of God, which may have an impact on the fulfillment of the services. In such unforeseen cases we will reimburse all the funds except for actual expenses incurred till the moment the higher force has occurred.

Insurance:

We are a licensed tour operator with an insurance guarantee. Travel cancellation and loss of luggage insurance is not included. We recommend that you take out additional insurance against withdrawal from the contract, accidents, and for more extensive medical treatment.

In case of any diseases – please inform us about it. We will do our best to check for solutions and help you during our tour, however please be aware that you are taking personal responsibility of your health condition.

Complaints:

If a service included in our Tour cannot be delivered objectively to the Customer's expectation, we must be notified immediately so as to allow for the opportunity to remedy the situation.

All formal complaints must be submitted in writing (email, regular mail) no later than 10 days after the end of the Tour. The client is requested to report timely anything they were not satisfied with. Delayed complaints decrease our ability to deal with the problem and will thus exclude our responsibility.

We will refund the difference between the contracted services and the replacement services, on the condition that the Client does not receive replacement services of the same or higher value.

The Client covers the costs of all replacement and extra services of a higher value if they are delivered at his/her request.
