

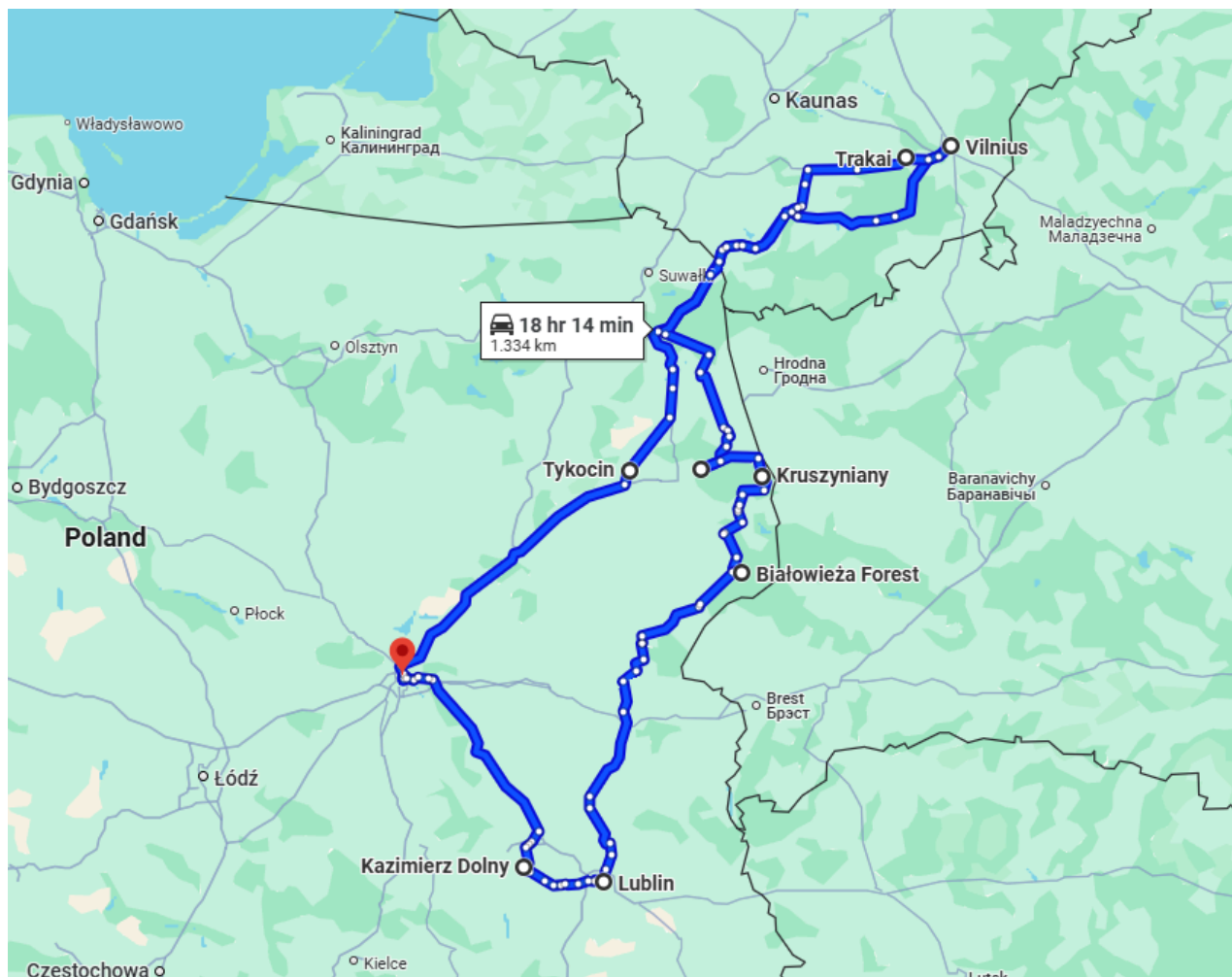


## Kingdom of Poland Tour by PolishOrigins September 5 - 15, 2026

**Day 1 (Saturday) 5 September 2026 Warsaw**

Arrival in Warsaw. Airport transfer to the hotel in the center of Warsaw, some time to rest after the flight. In the evening the group will be welcomed by the English speaking guide.

Dinner in one of the restaurants in Warsaw (3 course menu with water, tea or coffee).

Accommodation: 4\* hotel in Warsaw



## Day 2 (Sunday) 6 September 2026 **Warsaw**

Guided tour in Warsaw, introducing the capital of Poland with its Old Town, which was meticulously rebuilt after World War II. It is an outstanding example of a near-total reconstruction of a span of history covering the 13th to the 20th centuries, and as a result, was placed on the UNESCO World Heritage list.



We will also take you to Łazienki Park, where you will have the opportunity to listen to the open-air Chopin music concert.



In the afternoon entrance to the [POLIN Museum of the History of Polish Jews](#). It is not a well-known fact that most of Warsaw's population before WW2 were Jews, which made up about 30% of the community! The core exhibition of the museum presents the thousand-year history of Polish Jews. We will be immersed in the world of Polish Jews, from their arrival in Poland as traveling merchants in medieval times until today. The exhibition of the POLIN museum is stunning. A huge number of sources were selected that use modern technologies. The museum earned awards and is currently one of the best in Poland.

### **Day 3 (Monday) 7 September 2026 Warsaw - Tykocin**

Morning departure from Warsaw to Tykocin. You will enter the beautifully renovated synagogue from the 17th century.

Tykocin, one of the oldest towns in the region, and an important residence of Polish and Lithuanian kings since medieval times. Nowadays this is a picturesque example of the small Polish town at the Narew riverbanks.

In the synagogue you can admire the historic wall paintings and decorative ceiling.

In the afternoon arrival at the Wigry lake at Suwalki Lakeland. If weather permits, we will have a boat cruise on beautiful Wigry lake. During the cruise, it is possible to observe many rare species of birds, and the spectacular views of the camaldolese monastery, beautifully located on the peninsula. The lake is a part of a famous canoe trail of John Paul II.

#### **Day 4 (Tuesday) 8 September 2026 Tykocin - Vilnius**

Today you will leave Poland for a while and go to the capital of Lithuania: Vilnius. The history of these two countries was intertwined for centuries.

You will spend the next two days in Vilnius, UNESCO World Heritage Site with one of the biggest "Old Towns" in Europe (it is three times bigger than Kraków's Old Town).

Upon arrival, you will have walking tour with local guide, visiting Gate of Dawn, Russian Orthodox church of the Holy spirit, Town Hall, Pilies Str, Literatu Str, Amber Museum, St. Ann's Church, Visit in the church of St. Peter and Paul

Vilnius has always been an important cultural center and melting pot. Because of its large Jewish community, Napoleon named it "Jerusalem of the North".

We will also follow the Polish paths of Vilnius history.

In the evening you will enjoy the hospitality of the Vilnius people, during a dinner at one of the Old Town's restaurants.

#### **Day 5 (Wednesday) 9 September 2026 Vilnius and Trakai**

In the morning, we will make a trip to Troki (Trakai) to visit the 600 year-old castle located on an island.

A notable feature of Trakai is that the town was built and preserved by people of different nationalities. Historically, communities of Tatars, Lithuanians, Russians, Jews and Poles lived here. You will also learn about the Trakai Karaites minority, resettled here from Crimea, after the military campaigns against the Golden Horde in the 14th century.

In the afternoon, we return to Vilnius and have dinner in one of the restaurants serving the traditional Lithuanian cuisine (3 course menu with water, tea or coffee).

Accommodation: 4\* Hotel in the center of Vilnius

### **Day 6 (Thursday) 10 September 2026 Vilnius - Supraśl - Kruszyniany - Białowieża forest**

We'll leave Vilnius and head back to Poland, stopping for a short break along the way.

Once we cross the border, we'll visit the Orthodox Monastery in Supraśl, founded in the 16th century. Over time, it became an important center of Orthodox culture, known for its large library and connections to other key sites like the Kiev Lavra and Mount Athos Monastery.

In the afternoon, we'll visit Kruszyniany to see Poland's oldest wooden Tatar mosque. Known as a cultural melting pot, this village is where three religions - Catholicism, Islam, and Orthodoxy - have long come together.

Then our evening arrival in the Białowieża Forest.

### **Day 7 (Friday) 11 September 2026 Białowieża forest**

Today, you'll get a chance to experience the wild beauty of the Białowieża Forest. In the morning, we'll look for bison, which sometimes wander right into the village. Later, we'll visit Hajnówka to see the European bison up close at the Show Reserve in Białowieża National Park.

There will also be some time to take a rest and relax in the hotel's swimming pool and wellness centre.

### **Day 8 (Saturday) 12 September 2026 Białowieża forest - Lublin**

After breakfast, we will drive to the multicultural city of Lublin.

On our way to Lublin, we'll stop at Kozłówka to visit the stunning Zamoyski family residence. Once in Lublin, we'll explore the charming Old Town, filled with historic landmarks and picturesque alleys.

For centuries, Lublin thrived as a multicultural hub, attracting people from all over - Poles, Russians, Jews, Germans, Scots, Italians, French, Hungarians, and Armenians - thanks to its location at the crossroads of major trade routes and its renowned fairs.

In the afternoon, we'll take a guided tour of Lublin's Old Town, including the impressive Lublin Castle and its Holy Trinity Chapel, famous for its beautiful Byzantine frescoes. We'll round off the day with a taste of local cuisine at a cozy restaurant in the main square.

### **Day 9 (Sunday) 13 September 2026 Roztocze region**

We will invite you to discover the Roztocze National Park: featuring Polish Pony breeding and the natural, wild forest in Florianka. We will then visit the town of Zwierzyniec, with its picturesque chapel on the water, and then the renaissance town of Zamość.

Dinner (3 course menu with water, tea and coffee)

After that travel back to Lublin

Accommodation: 3\* Hotel in the Old Town in Lublin

### **Day 10 (Monday) 14 September 2026 Lublin - Kazimierz Dolny - Warsaw**

After breakfast your guide will take you to Kazimierz Dolny, one of the most beautifully situated little towns in Poland. Since the 19th century, it has been attracting artists, actors and summer residents.

In Kazimierz you will visit the castle and tower, you will see the parish church with one of the oldest Polish organs, famous Senatorska Street and walk by the Vistula River.

After that travel to Warsaw where you will explore [Wilanów Palace](#) a baroque royal residence, property of Jan III Sobieski, one of the last great kings of Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth

**Day 11 (Tuesday) 15 September 2026 Warsaw - departures**

The day of your departure from Warsaw.

We will arrange the transfers to the train station or to the airport in Warsaw.
